5:00pm Field Visit

- **Four members** of your group have been given the opportunity to go onto the warning track, behind home plate, prior to the game. *Absolutely no more than four members will be allowed to participate in the pre-game field visit.*
- Only the four participants will be allowed down on to the field with the Cardinals representative. Family and friends can enter **at 5:15** through Gate 2 to watch from field-level sections 149-150.
- Participants should meet inside the **420 South 8th Street Lobby** at **5:00pm**. The lobby is located on the west side of the Stadium between **gates 2 and 3**.
- Upon arrival, check in with the receptionist and let them know what group you are with.
- Your Cardinals Representative (or a fellow Representative) will meet the group in the lobby and escort them to the warning track for the field visit. Please contact your Cardinals Representative if you have questions.
- Players will occasionally sign autographs. It is **not guaranteed** that you will get one, but it is better to have something just in case.
- Please submit the names of the four guests to your Cardinals Representative one week before the game.

Please note: Batting practice is subject to change. In the event that BP does not occur, you will still have an opportunity to go on the field and take pictures, weather permitting.

6:10 pm Arrival Time for Performers

- Meet your Cardinals Representative **inside Gate 1**, located at the Southeast corner of the ballpark. Tickets are scanned upon entry. *Gates will open at 5:45.*
- Your Cardinals Representative will escort the group down the ramps to field access.
- Parents are not to come down the ramp with the performers. Only 2-3 chaperones in addition to the director will be allowed. *Please approve any others.*
- The performers will have time to line up and practice before they go onto the field.

6:40 pm Walk onto the Field

- You will stay in your lines as you follow the representative onto the warning track
- The group will perform from behind home plate in most cases. This may change depending on weather or scheduled pre-game events. Any band larger than 50 people and some larger choirs will perform on the Right Field warning track
- Microphones will be set up
- The performance will take place at approximately **6:55 pm**
- Once you are done, you must exit the field quickly as the game will start shortly after
- The group will be escorted up the east ramp, to the main concourse. If parents would like to meet their children, they can wait outside of section **130** by the ramp

Please advise that anyone not singing to go to his or her seats to watch. The 2-3 chaperones may watch the performance from the right field entrance.
